

Flex Days FAQ:

What is a “Flex Day”?

- A flex day is an alternate day of game play that differs from your “normally” scheduled league night. Example: You play in a Tuesday night league but one of your games in the season may be scheduled for a Sunday evening.

What is the purpose of implementing Flex Days:

- Our goal is to always grow the programs as much as possible, while preserving the quality of the product. We understand that for us to grow the leagues and provide all of the teams with more competition, that equates to a larger amount of games throughout the week.
- Flex Days are our way of still growing the league while keeping the amount of late games throughout the season to a minimum. Additionally, it allows us to make-up for any days that we may not schedule games due to players wanting off for holidays.

You may be thinking, “But I play on a Tuesday night league, all of my games should be on Tuesday!”:

- While this has historically been the way we’ve run the leagues, we feel that the introduction to Flex Days will be a positive, not a negative. We will always advertise what days are scheduled for Flex Days at the start of registration so that you have plenty of time to coordinate your schedule in advance.

You may be saying, “Why don’t they just extend the league season, that would be so much easier”?

- While this is what we’ve done in the past, we’ve reached a point where we have grown our leagues to almost capacity in the sense of the number of teams we can fit within a night without having 11:00 games and later. Extending the season would give teams multiple byes throughout the season, which most players do not like.

Another question you may be asking is, “Why don’t they just take less teams each season”?

- There are a couple of reasons why we are not at a point of capping our leagues. The first one is that the more teams we have playing in the leagues, the more competition there is for all of you. Our main priority is providing a quality product for our guests and the amount of competition provided is part of what makes a quality product. The second reason is that we are a business and do need to make money, therefore we will always be looking for ways to grow the business without sacrificing the quality of the product.
