

### <u>How to Access</u> <u>your Team</u> <u>Roster</u>

#### 1. Go to:

<u>www.beachfieldhouse.com – click Member Login (Upper Right Corner)</u>

- 2. Log in using your Username and Password.
- 3. This is your Dashboard From this page you will click on the "Manage Team" or "View Team" button to see the team roster.
- 4. When you click on the "Manage Team" button, then click on a name –you will be able to see the players contact information.

#### • Game Schedule

• As you can see from the schedule, games are very quick, and we have very little turnaround time. There are few things we will need to make sure we do to be as efficient as possible:

- Please have your team prepared ready to play once the previous game has ended. This means cleats, shin guards, etc... are on and players are ready to go.
  \*Warm-up time, if any, will be very minimal – 1 to 2 minutes.
- Keep personal items to a minimum. The less you bring into the fields, the less you will need to take out after the game.
- STAGING AREA to allow teams to exit the player boxes, please enter the fields from the STAGING AREA. These are located opposite the players box with a door to enter the fields. *They are located between Fields 1 and 2, Field 2 and 3, and located on the Basketball Court side, by the exterior wall of the facility.*

### GAME DAY RULES





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#### **COMPETITION FORMAT & RULES**

Official FIFA Rules and Regulations as stated under the Laws of The Game will be enforced. Exceptions are noted below under the Field House Rules.

#### **FIELD HOUSE RULES**

- 20 MINUTE HALVES, running clock.
- No Time-Outs.
- NO SLIDING / SLIDE TACKLING
- NO Heading for players 2011/2012 and below
- Goalkeepers cannot punt or drop kick the ball

• All restarts will be *INDIRECT, other than a PK.* 

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### Play- 2015 -2018

- 2015/2016 (U7/U8) & 2017/2018 (U5/U6) Divisions play 4v4 – no goalie.
- Game Time: 8-minute quarters (2017/2018), 10-minute quarters (or 2–20minute halves) (2015/2016)
- Size 3 Ball
- Scores will not be recorded games are focus on skill development and building the love of the game!



### Play- 2003 -2013

- 7v7 w/Goalie
- Game Time: 20-minute halves, 2-minute halftime
- HOME JERSEY: Light, AWAY JERSEY: Dark

\*If teams have only 1 jersey, we will provide pinnies.

- Size 4 or 5 Ball
- Scores will be recorded we will stop keeping score if the goal differential goes to 8 goals or more.

### Outdoor vs Indoor

- Outdoor Touch Lines; Indoor No touch lines
  - Any ball that travels into a player box or netting above the glass will have a restart at the point of contact. A ball hit by an offensive player to the back of the goal netting will be awarded to the Goalie; conversely if a defense player hits the ball above the goal – it will be a corner kick. (Indirect kick)
- **Outdoor** Offsides; **Indoor** no offsides, 3-line rule
- **Outdoor** subs based on Referee; **Indoor** sub on the fly \*player must be within the bench area (1/2 wall)
- **Outdoor** Slide tackling dependent upon age; **Indoor** NO SLIDE TACKLING! (Or rough play around the Boards)

Note: Any dangerous play or potentially dangerous play will be called by the Referee around the boards – we want players to be safe!



### 3-Line Rule

• Three Line Indoor Soccer Rule Soccer is when the ball is kicked from one end of the field through the air in which it crosses all 3-lines.

- These lines are evenly spaced along the length of the field, with one of them being the exact center. The rule is used to avoid playing long balls and to keep the ball on the ground.
- **Restart:** The ball will be placed at the **MIDFIELD** line. (*Restart will be indirect kick*)
