



VBFH Tournament Rules

- * **SPORTSMANSHIP:** Any player/coach/spectator ejected *for fighting* will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the event. Nonphysical ejections will result in a one game ban (not including game of ejection). Head coaches are responsible for their players & parents conduct. Technical fouls with or without warning will be issued for any unsportsmanlike conduct by coaches, players, or spectators.
- * **PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:** A player is only allowed to play on one team; however, a player may also play on one additional team as long as it is <u>ABOVE</u> their age group and <u>WITHIN</u> their program. A player CAN NOT play on more than one team in one age group or with a different program.
- * <u>CLOCK:</u> 2, 20 minute halves Running time <u>ONLY</u> stops on team OR official time outs; Clock stops ON EVERY whistle last minute of the 1st half and last 2 minutes on the 2nd half <u>ONLY</u>.
- * **FOULS/BONUS:** FT's: (1 and 1) on 10th team foul <u>NO DOUBLE BONUS</u> 5 fouls = disqualification.
- * TIME-OUTS: 4 per game 2, 60 second and 2, 30 second.
- * **OVERTIME:** Two minutes. 1, 30 second, timeout (no carryovers). Additional overtimes are 1 minute with 1, 30 second timeout... REPEAT UNTIL WINNER.

* WARM-UP/HALF-TIME/GRACE:

- WARM-UPS: Minimum of 3 minutes.
- HALF-TIME: 2 Minutes
- GRACE: A 5 Minute grace period shall be given only if a team has less than 5 players
 OR the head coach is not present. Please arrive 20 minutes before scheduled time so that we may start early if possible.
- * <u>MERCY RULES:</u> 20 Point Lead = running clock in <u>2ND HALF</u> and defense behind half-court - lead must go to 19 or below to return to a stop clock/ability to press.

* TIE BREAKER:

- Head to Head
- Point Diff (+/- 15 max)
- Total points allowed
- Total points scored (If a team plays 4 games, their last game shall not count for or against them but will for opponent)





* **BALL:** All girls' teams & boys' in 3rd-6th grade will use a 28.5 ball. Boys' in 7th-12th grade will use a 29.5 regulation ball. Agreement from both head coaches can alter rule.

VHSL rules apply to manage remaining game play - officials have final say on game matters

HOME TEAM - Is listed first and shall wear a light-colored uniform. Home team is also responsible to PROVIDE THE OFFICIAL SCOREKEEPER (BOOK).

AWAY TEAM - Is listed and shall wear a dark-colored uniform, and PROVIDE PERSONNEL TO COVER THE CLOCK.
